### SUMMARY

Key Caps was always provided as a utility in earlier Macintosh releases; allowing you to see exactly which keys would produce which characters on your keyboard.

With the release of OSX this utility is no longer a separate utility, but has been integrated into the **System Preferences** of OSX and is now called *Keyboard Viewer*.

### RESOLUTION

#### *Enable Keyboard Viewer*

1. Select **System Preferences** from the **Apple** menu.
2. Click on the **International** panel.  
*This will display the international settings for your Macintosh account.*
3. Click the **Input Menu**.
4. Ensure **Show input menu in menu bar** is ticked.
5. Close the **System Preferences** window.
6. Select **Show Keyboard Viewer** from the **Flag** menulet.

*The Flag menulet can be located top-right of your screen, near to the time display.*

#### *Modify Keyboard Viewer Settings*

1. If the keyboard display is too small, just click the **Zoom** button to enlarge the window.
2. If you wish to see an alternative font displayed, just choose the relevant font set from the **Font** pop-up menu.
